

GUIDELINES FOR AUTHORS

Revista del CESLA is a scientific interdisciplinary annual edited by the Center for Latin American Studies of the Warsaw University.

Revista del CESLA welcomes articles devoted to contemporary socio-economic problems, historical essays as well as other short forms of expression such as polemics regarding the development, future and history of Latin American studies throughout the world. Furthermore, every issue contains reviews of recently published books which deal with Latin American investigation in its broadest sense. Articles of journalistic character are not accepted.

In accordance with CESLA's editorial policy, **all submitted texts** are subject to **double-blind** review by two **external experts**. Only original texts which have not been previously published are accepted. Once the article is approved for publication, the copyrights are transferred by the author to Revista del CESLA. Any request for use or reproduction for commercial purposes should be addressed to the editor of the journal. Likewise, every authorized reproduction in any medium should quote in full form the article and the journal. Every author receives one copy of the journal.

We accept articles in *.docx, *.doc or *.rtf **format**, not longer than 30 standard pages (1800 signs per page), written in Spanish, English, Portuguese or French. The submission should contain the title and names of authors as well as their institutional affiliation, postal address and a brief CV.

It is required that the article is accompanied with at least **two summaries**, one in the language of the article, the other in English (in Spanish if the article is in English). The summary should be not longer than 200 words and should also contain 5-7 keywords in respective languages.

The keywords should be separated with commas or semicolons.

Bibliographical references should be listed alphabetically and each entry should include: surnames and names of all the authors separated by commas, year in parenthesis, full title of the article, name of the editor, place of publication, volume and the number of the first and last page of each article (separated with a hyphen).

For example:

Monographs: Zea, Leopoldo, (1978), *Filosofía de la historia latinoamericana*, FCE, México.

Articles: Calvo Buezas, Tomás, (1978), "Hispanos en Estados Unidos y cultura", en: *Las culturas hispánicas en los Estados Unidos de América*, Asociación Hispano-Cultural Norteamericana, Madrid, pp. 34-45.

Internet: is similar to quote as an article, add the expression: "[online], available at": Quote from the website with the exact link, add at the end: "retrieved: date of consultation".

Footnotes should be written at the bottom of the page with continuous numeration.

Diagrams and tables (in black and white only) should be sent in the graphic format compatible with MS Windows or in *.jpg.
