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As usual, our journal contains articles on semantics and language confrontation, as well cognitive and theoretical linguistics. At present, a new trend is represented by works on semantic problems among computer linguists from the Group of Associate Professor Maciej Piasecki, who we cooperate with in the European Project CLARIN. In Volume 11th of CSEC, we also present works summing up the results of Mondilex — European Project 211938 MONDILEX — Conceptual Modelling of Networking of Centres for High-Quality Research in Slavic Lexicography and Their Digital Resources FP7-INFRASTRUCTURES-2007-1. Three articles in Volume 11 of CSEC concern the Polish-Bulgarian Project: “Logic and Language”, executed under the cooperation agreements between the Polish Academy of Sciences and the Bulgarian Academy of Sciences.

In this volume we publish several articles by young scientists. Some of them have just finished writing their Ph.D. theses, and some are at the very beginning of their scientific careers, but in our opinion all those works deserve attention, and may be of interest to our readers.
